**GOALS**

**Scope of Project**

- The Oral History Project will concentrate on the history of the traditional area covered by the Lewisville Township, as well as the incorporated city limits of the Town of Lewisville. This area from now on in this document and all Lewisville Historical Society Oral History Project documents will be referred to as “Lewisville”.
- The Project will concentrate on people who have grown up in and/or who have lived in Lewisville for at least 20 years.

**Purpose**

- The purpose of the Lewisville Historical Society’s Oral History Project is to gather and preserve memories and information from historically interesting people about their lives and what it was like growing up and living in Lewisville.
- The information will be gathered by means of interviews conducted by Lewisville Historical Society members.

**End Products**

- Information collected will be in the form of typed transcripts of interviews.
- Other end products may include some or all of the following:
  - Completed Interviewee Fact Sheet.
  - Completed Interview Summary Form
  - Recordings (audio and/or video and/or digital)
  - Photographs
  - Genealogies
- At least two (2) copies of all end products of the interview will be generated. The total will be three (3): the original and two (2) copies. One copy will go to the interviewee. The original and one copy will become part of the Historical Archives of the Lewisville Historical Society. The copy will be made available to the public for education and research. The original will be archived.

**Uses of Information**

- This material will be made available for genealogical, historical, and other educational research, and for public education about the area’s heritage.
